Nicole Larkin is a Sydney based designer focusing on digital fabrication techniques and craftsmanship. Her work explores the blurred boundaries between art, architecture, sculpture and traditional craftsmanship. She holds a Bachelor of Design in Architecture and Masters of Architecture from the University of Sydney, NSW.

Nicole pursues parallel career paths in both art and architecture. Since 2011 she has worked with the award winning architecture firm Tzannes across varied project types. In 2014 she became an artist in residence at 107 Projects, a City of Sydney arts initiative in Redfern, NSW.

Nicole has exhibited two major installation pieces with Sculpture by the Sea. It is the southern hemisphere's largest outdoor sculpture exhibition. Her body of work focuses on classic and contemporary ways to view art and exploring ideas on the authentic and the reproduction.
